**Stop One:** Leonard Dawson, a local farmer in Fackler, AL, started the Rock Zoo in the 1970s after a large boulder was moved onto his property when County Road 32 was being built. He took one look at that rock and saw a rooster. Over the years, Leonard's rock zoo grew and so did the visitors. You will also get a drive-by history tour of the "Real" Hollywood, which is my stomping grounds and my hometown (Angie).



### **Stop Two:**

**THE VIRGIN OF THE POOR SHRINE** - Tucked away on a long country road is a shrine dedicated to the Virgin Mary; a replica of a world-famous sacred site that is one of the most holy of places of the Catholic church. This lovely chapel, with its mosaics and statues, is a reproduction of the Sanctuary of the Virgin of the Poor shrine found in Belgium where miracles are said to occur to this very day. **We each will bring a packed lunch to enjoy during this quiet time at the Shrine in Tennessee. We will walk the property outdoors.**

**Stop Three:** The Sweet & Savory Classroom in Chattanooga. In this private group class, you will get your hands dirty and learn how to make "**The Soiree**" - **Shrimp Flatbread, Grilled Flank Steak w/Charred Lemons, Bourbon Berry Cobbler.** After you prepare your meal, you will get to taste your skills and enjoy your dish.
